Then we take you to our aviaries, where you will see various species of birds. You will see exotic and local birds and endangered and non-endangered birds. Following this, we take you to our main barn and show you where some of the day-to-day action of our conservation centre happens, including a look at our bird nursery. We walk a bit more and see more exotic birds and another exotic (non-bird) species. Next, it's time for a ride on the tram! We take you out to our Vancouver Island Marmot habitat, where you will likely see young marmots playing and basking in the sun. We come back on the tram and stop to see small wild cats.
